

Kirk Family Foundation Criteria for Distributions

The KFF has been established by the Kirk Family to meet the following aims:

- (i) to promote and provide opportunities for children and adolescents in Queanbeyan, Palerang and Yass regions.
- (ii) to promote and support the needs of underprivileged children and adolescents in Queanbeyan, Palerang and Yass regions;
- (iii) to promote and provide opportunities for the underprivileged children and adolescents in Queanbeyan, Palerang and Yass regions to gain employment or self employment through the establishment of their own businesses or enterprises; and
- (iv) to promote and provide for educational opportunities and training for underprivileged children and adolescents in Queanbeyan, Palerang and Yass regions.

To ensure that these aims are met and that the KFF can continue to support others, it requests that recipients comply with the following criteria:

- The recipient and where applicable, the nominated beneficiary, agree to sign any necessary documents to enable the KFF to publicise the funding of the recipient and/or the nominated beneficiary. This right to release information (if used) will be based on individual cases and discretion will always be paramount.
- Recipients and nominated beneficiaries are to make themselves reasonably available upon request of the KFF to attend functions publicise the work of the KFF and for fund raising purposes. This would only be requested once or twice per year. No payment for their attendance should be expected.
